Ecological Restoration Project at Marott Park Nature Preserve

Restoration will begin in early January at the Northeast corner of Marott Park on 22 acres of former agricultural field.

Attached are a brochure and restoration summary that explains the strategy being used to reestablish a native floodplain forest.
